Statistics show growth.

We started last January with a total of 1019 students. We now have 1330 students at the end of March. Of course, there are students who are released, moved to facilities that we do not serve or are simply no longer interested in continuing with the course, but despite that we consistently show a healthy growth curve. In 2025, our mentors marked a total of 10 195 lessons and for the first 3 months of this year, an additional 2 911 lessons have already been marked. We still need more mentors to be able to handle this increasing workload. If you know of someone who would be interested in becoming a mentor, you can refer them to the office for more information

Johannesburg Prison:

Early last year we started visiting two sections of the Johannesburg Prison, namely Section B where we serve 10

students and Section C where we serve 21 students.

We are also very grateful that we can now serve the Women's Prison there from the end of February. We met a number of ladies who have already started Crossroads courses in some of our other prisons. We started with about 8 students and now have 26 in total. It is amazing how the Lord opens doors where it seems impossible.



Mentor tips:

Remember to encourage the student with positive comments throughout. Write this in the lesson, Roadmaps and build on it in the letter to the student. This is invaluable to them.

Always respond to prayer requests if there are any or encourage them to share any requests with the mentor. Make sure the lesson, roadmap and your letter are all neatly placed back in the student's envelope before sending it back to the office.
